Rules for Gaeltacht scholarships 2019

This year there will be six scholarships of €300 with two confined to entrants who have competed in Scor/Scor na nÓg competitions.

All entrants must be members of a GAA club in Co. Roscommon and a secondary School student in 2018/19 school year.

Three of the scholarships are sponsored by and are confined to Colaiste Cu Chulainn in Gweedore. Courses in Gweedore are €595 and last for two weeks.

Successful entrants in 2017/2018 are not eligible to enter in 2019. Scholarships are for attendance at residential Gaeltacht courses.

To enter please complete an entry form and one essay from the two titles -
